This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.94 dated 27.09.2017 under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 471 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he had taken an amount of ₹5,90,000/- from the complainant for getting him a job in the Army.

On instructions from HC Jaspal Singh, learned State counsel states that the investigation in this case is complete, challan has been presented and the trial has commenced.

The petitioner is in custody since 13.11.2018. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Keeping in view the above and without expressing any opinion on

the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
