This petition has been filed under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C. read with Section 36-A(4) NDPS Act for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 60 dated 11.05.2014, under Sections 15, 25, 61 and 85 NDPS Act, registered at PS Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 15.09.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer/Illaq Magistrate/trial Court concerned, till the date on which the reference is decided. It was also made clear that the petitioner would appear before the trial Court when required and any default would result into cancellation of interim bail.

Vide order dated 22.11.2019, the State counsel was directed to file the affidavit whether any other FIR has been registered against the petitioner after the grant of bail to him.

In this case, neither any reply has been filed by the respondent-State nor there is any material on record to reveal that any other FIR has been registered or is pending against the petitioner.

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As the petitioner has been on interim bail since 15.09.2016 and there is no material on record to reveal that any other FIR has been registered or is pending against the petitioner, the order dated 15.09.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute qua petitioner-Jammu.
