ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.

This is 2nd petition for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 25.06.2017 under Sections 21/61 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ferozepur Cantt., District Ferozepur.

First petition i.e. CRM-M-27179-2017 was dismissed as withdrawn on 27.09.2017.

As per allegations in the FIR, the police party was present at Octroi No.7, Ferozepur Cantt and on receiving an information that Natha Singh son of Late Surjan Singh, his son Gursewak Singh @ Sewak Singh, Raju Singh @ Raju-petitioner and his brother Jaswant Singh @ Jassa Singh are carrying heavy quantity of heroine from the smugglers of Pakistan and they will store it at Indo-Pak boarder on the Ferozepur side, in their land as well as in the land of other people and after getting the place of hiding of

narcotics, it can be recovered. On receiving this information, police registered an FIR and conducted the investigation.

The Additional Sessions Judge, vide order dated 23.07.2018, had dismissed the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner, noticing the fact that even on earlier occasion, same application was dismissed on 06.07.2017 by the same Court and considering the fact that there are serious allegations against the petitioner and other accused persons, again dismissed the bail application.

As noticed above, first bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn.

Considering the fact that there are serious allegations of keeping narcotic substances, in the FIR and also considering the conduct of the petitioner, who is evading his arrest since the date of registration of FIR on 25.06.2017 and is filing repeated applications for anticipatory bail, this petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.5,000/-.
