Since the Bar is on strike, the Lawyers are abstaining from work and no one is appearing.

This petition is pending since 2018.

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his biological father Kulwant Singh, at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7.

A perusal of the petition show that the petitioner's claim is that he has been adopted by one Nirmala Devi – respondent No.6 and respondents No.4, 5 and 7, are stated to be relative of Nirmala Devi. It is further stated that the private respondents are keeping an eye on the property of the father of the petitioner namely Jaswant Singh and they are threatening him.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Shri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar dated 11.01.2019 is already on record and in the reply, it is stated on verification of the facts, it is found that the biological father of the petitioner Kulwant

Singh and respondent No.6 Nirmala Devi are having a dispute regarding partition of a land situated in the village and the matter is pending before the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Naib Tehsildar, Shri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar and in this regard, the police has entered a DDR No.21 dated 25.09.2018 under Sections 107 and 151 Cr.P.C. It is further stated that the petitioner has recorded a statement in the enquiry that now he has no dispute with respondent No.7 and is not having any threat to his life and liberty.

Separate reply on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 is also on record, in which it is stated that a compromise has been effected between the parties and the dispute was primarily regarding construction of a partition wall, which has already been completed in terms of the compromise dated 02.10.2018 (Annexure R-2).

In view of the above, no further action is called for.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed.
