Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.18 dated 25.05.2017 registered under Sections 498-A/406/420/120-B of IPC at Police Station Women, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 09.05.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

However, pursuant to aforesaid order, a communication dated 11.07.2018 was received from the learned Magistrate that none of the parties appeared before the trial Court for recording their statements. Again vide two subsequent orders dated 11.10.2018 and 05.12.2018 passed by this

Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, but vide communications dated 03.12.2018 & 04.02.2019, it was informed that none of the parties appeared before the learned Magistrate for recording their statements.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of present petition, however, with liberty to file fresh one in case the compromise is arrived at between the parties or on merits, as the case may be.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
