The grievance of the petitioner is that he had made a complaint against respondent No.7 because the said respondent had trespassed into his house and had assaulted him but instead the police has registered an FIR against the petitioner, which is absolutely false and is the result of connivance with the police officials. The local Panchayat has also passed a resolution in favour of the petitioner. Thereafter, a detailed representation dated 25.2.2019 (Annexure P-7) has been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Keeping in view the nature of order being passed, no reply is necessary to be filed.
