The present petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India challenging therein order dated 13.12.2018 (Annexure P-16) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Barnala (for short – the Trial Court) rejecting the petitioner's application filed by him for dismissal of respondent No.1's suit. The second prayer made by the petitioner is to club the suit filed by respondent No.1 to challenge the decree dated 14.12.2010 passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Barnala with the other Civil Suit filed by respondent No.1 through which she seeks damages from respondent No.3.

After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for and is granted permission to withdraw the present petition qua the challenge made by the petitioner to the order dated 13.12.2018 (Annexure P-16).

So far as the aforesaid prayer made by the petitioner qua clubbing of the aforesaid two suits is concerned, since in the first instance, no such application has been filed by the petitioner before the Trial Court,

learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this prayer with liberty to move an appropriate application before the Trial Court to seek such relief. In the facts of the present case, this request made by Mr. Attariwala, is accepted.

The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
