Prayer in the aforesaid two petitions is for quashing of FIR No.447 dated 01.05.2016 registered under Sections 467, 468, 471,406, 248, 279 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Gurugram, District Gurugram and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

Respondent No.4 has not been served, as per the office report.

As per the affidavit filed by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sadar Gurugram, during the investigation, 69 victims have appeared at the first instance and have made a statement that they do not want to pursue the FIR as per the request made vide Annexure R1, attached with this affidavit.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surinder Kumar, submits that remaining 28 victims have also appeared before the Investigating Officer and have made a similar statement that they do not want to pursue the FIR and accordingly, the cancellation report was prepared on 08.03.2019 and the same will be submitted within a period of 04 weeks from today.

In view of the above, these petitions are disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner(s) to approach the trial Court for redressal of their grievances, if any.
