Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the matter and further proceed against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3—Senior Superintendent of Police Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, is directed to look into representation dated 19.02.2019 (P-2) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3—Senior Superintendent of Police Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, to decide representation dated 19.02.2019 (P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
