Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-bank to enter into tripartite agreement with the prospective purchasers who are the family members of petitioners No.2 and 3 for the purchase of two shops.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to either approach the bank or to avail the alternative remedies as are available to it, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
