HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner is accused in case FIR No.175 dated 20.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

The allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with Tejbir Singh, Ajay Kumar and Sumish Kumar, caused injuries on the right arm of the complainant-Amritpal Singh with beer bottle. The trial in the case has already been commenced. There are a total of 8 prosecution witnesses. The complainant and injured have already been examined and only official witnesses remained to be examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is an NRI and because of the pendency of this case, he is facing great hardship. The case was registered in 2016. His limited prayer is that the trial of the case be expedited.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts the notice on behalf of the State.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by requesting the learned trial Court to make endeavor to dispose of the case expeditiously, preferably within a period of four months. The prosecution is requested to ensure no needless time is taken in producing and examining the prosecution witnesses.
