Counsel for the petitioners is not present. Similar was the position on 09.08.2019.

Present petition has been filed with following substantive prayer:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and direction to the respondents no.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of police officials in the interest of justice and fair play.”

On notice, affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, has been filed. Paragraphs 3 and 4 of the affidavit are extracted as under:-

“3. That thereafter, another notice NO.491/5A/PS/STN dated 23.5.2018 was served upon the petitioners for 26.05.2018. The said notice was duly served upon the petitioner No.1 on 23.05.2018 but instead of coming to the police station, the petitionenr No.1 on 23.05.2018 made a report on the said notice that “We have already filed a petition in the High Court and the matter will be discussed and solved in the office of I.G.P.”. Sd/- Tejinder Kaur 23.05.2018. copy of notice dated 23.5.2018 is attached herewith as Annexure R-3/T. But the petitioners did not come present in the police station to join the enquiry of the above noted application.

4. That the petitioners have cheated above noted Jagsir Singh s/o Sampuran Singh and Respondent No.6-Mandeep Singh for Rs.20 lacs on the pretext of making them partners in the school. Neither the petitioners returned their money nor made them partners in the above noted school. Instead of joining the enquiry of the above noted application, the petitioners filed the present petition on wrong facts before this Hon'ble Court, which is not maintainable.”

In view of the aforesaid affidavit, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.
