Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.30 dated 24.03.2018 under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 11.03.2019:-

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, 50 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from the possession of the petitioner from the place of his residence. It is further argued that the recovery has already been effected and the petitioner was not arrested at the spot.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for

any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jitender Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
