In response to the petition, reply dated 26.04.2018 by way of affidavit of Bhupinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 stands filed which reveals that after completion of investigation, 17 accused persons were challaned and charges were framed by the trial Court on 09.12.2017. Thereafter, trial commenced and prosecution adduced its

evidence.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh has apprised the Court that 17 prosecution witnesses have been examined so far out of total 34 witnesses.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has no instructions in this case as the client has taken away brief from him.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, no ground is made out to transfer the investigation of the case to some independent agency.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
