Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.74 dated 21.04.2018 under Sections 455, 511, 506, 427, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 10.05.2018: -

*“It is stated that there was a minor dispute between the parties, as a result of which, an FIR on the basis of wrong allegations has been lodged by the complainant against the petitioner. Petitioner is stated to be an old aged woman of 61 years....”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of DSP, Sub Division, Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Rural) in the Court today and it is stated in para No.3 that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has however opposed the bail on the ground that complainant is still at threat at the hands of accused persons.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
