This order shall dispose of two petitions i.e. ***CRM-M-21810-2013*** titled as ***Ravinder Singh and another Versus State of Punjab and another*** and ***CRM-M-16301-2013*** titled as ***Bikramjit Singh and another Versus State of Punjab and another.***

Prayer in both these petitions filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.75 dated 04.12.2011 registered under Sections 306/452/341/506/323/34 of IPC (Section 324 of IPC added lateron) at Police Station Chohla Sahib, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

No one is present on behalf of the petitioners.

In compliance of order dated 19.12.2018 passed by this Court, learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Ravinderpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, on behalf of respondent No.1-State of Punjab, which is taken on record.

Having recourse to the status report so filed, learned State counsel states that in the aforesaid FIR, the police has completed investigation and has submitted a cancellation report before the court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Tarn Taran. Even the statement of the complainant-Kulwinder Kaur has also been recorded by the Illaqa Magistrate on 06.03.2019. The cancellation report so submitted by the State has duly been accepted by the Illaqa Magistrate. In this manner, the proceedings pertaining to the FIR have been dropped by the Illaqa Magistrate.

In view of the reply so submitted by learned State counsel, the present petitions are rendered infructuous as in the FIR, cancellation report has already been accepted by the Illaqa Magistrate.

Dismissed as infructuous.
