The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is to the Ex-party arbitral award dated 23.06.2017 (**Annexure P-3**) passed by the sole arbitrator-respondent No.4 as well as the execution proceedings (**Annexure P-4**).

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
