The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.193 dated 04.07.2018 under Sections 307, 34, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Farrukhnagar, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no overt act has been attributed to the petitioner and the injuries which were received by the complainant are alleged to have been caused by co-accused, namely, Puneet who is in custody. The petitioner is in custody for over ten months and co-accused, namely, Rahul has been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-5854 of 2019 on 13.02.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, states that 5 out of 28 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is now listed for 20.09.2019 for examination of remaining PWs.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when no injury has been attributed to the petitioner, he is in custody for almost ten months, co-accused, namely, Rahul has been granted regular bail and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
