Petitioner has challenged the order dated 25.1.2019 (Annexure P1) passed by the Superintendent District Jail, Rohtak, vide which, his emergency parole for three weeks to enable him to perform Tehravi ceremony and last rites/ rituals on account of death of his mother on 8.1.2019 was declined.

It comes out that Tehravi ceremony and last rites/ rituals on account of death of his mother is already over. Therefore, the ground to attend Tehravi ceremony and last rites/ rituals on account of death of his mother is not more available to the petitioner. The petitioner, if so advised, may file fresh application, if any other ground is available to him.

The present writ petition stands dismissed accordingly.
