The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 65 dated 30.03.2018 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Division No.5, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 01 PW has been examined till date out of a total of 08 PWs. There are no other criminal cases pending/decided against the petitioner and thus, he may be released on regular bail.

The aforementioned factual submissions have not been controverted by the learned State counsel.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, at Jalandhar.
