Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.114, dated 12.10.2018 and to take action against respondents No.4 to 6 in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2—Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, is directed to look into the matter, in a time-bound manner.

A perusal of record shows that there is no representation moved on behalf of the petitioner to any of the police authorities. Therefore, instant petition is liable to be dismissed.

However, having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2—

Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the representation, if any, moved by the petitioner and do the needful, if required, within two months by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
