Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.145 dated 23.08.2018 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Nawanshaher, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner namely Paramjit Kaur has already been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 21.01.2019 passed in CRM-M-1639-2019. It is further submitted that the petitioner was granted interim bail for some time, awaiting the FSL report and thereafter, he has surrendered before the Court and is in custody. It is also submitted that the petitioner was earlier involved in another case and he stands acquitted in that case on 04.04.2019. Learned counsel further submits that total recovery from the petitioner is of 10 injections of Buprenorphine (2 ml each), which is not more than commercial

quantity.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate 18.03.2019 filed in the Court today, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything further on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
