This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioners Rajpal Kaur and Jashanpreet Singh in case bearing FIR No.62 dated 27.02.2017 registered at Police Station City Sangrur under Section 354D IPC, Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 11.03.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, Police Station City Sangrur who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered

from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 11.03.2019 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
