Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.336 dated 13.11.2017 under Sections 379-B, 34, 411, 201 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station 'A' Division, District Amritsar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 02.04.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for recording their respective statements in support of the compromise. In pursuance thereof, the trial Court has submitted a report dated 06.05.2019 that no effective compromise appears to have been effected between the parties. Thereafter, again on 24.05.2018, learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant sought time to appear before the trial Court for recording the statements of the parties and the same was granted.

The trial Court has again submitted a report dated 02.07.2019 that despite availing ample opportunities, the parties have not turned up to record their statements.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the parties to file fresh petition, if they still acknowledge the compromise.
