AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 31.08.2016 passed in CWP No. 17897 of 2016.

The petitioner was appointed Lambardar of village Bhukhri Kalan Tehsil Ludhiana (East). He was removed from the said post, aggrieved of the said order petitioner filed a civil writ petition bearing No. 17897 of 2016. Vide interim order dated 31.08.2016, the operation of impugned order dated 26.04.2016 was stayed. In spite of the stay order, respondent No.2 was appointed as Lambardar during the pendency of the civil writ petition. Hence, the present contempt petition.

Reply was filed by respondent No.1 stating that respondent No.2 has been terminated from the post of Lambardar and an inquiry has been conducted in which they came to the conclusion that the stay order was kept lying in the peshi

branch and was never processed. It has further been mentioned in the reply that a show cause notice has been issued to the Reader to the Deputy Commissioner.

In view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

Respondent No.1 shall inform this Court with regard to the outcome of the show cause notice issued to the Reader to the Deputy Commissioner.
