AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 26.04.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.7001 of 2013.

In pursuance to order dated 17.07.2019, Dr. Avneet Kaur, Director Health Services, Punjab is present in the Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Dr. Avneet Kaur, states that the exercise for compliance of directions of this Court was initiated during the pendency of the review application filed by the respondents and needful with regard to fixation of notional pay scale would be done within four weeks from today and arrears would be paid within 14 weeks thereafter.

In view of statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no interference is required in the contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

However, it is made clear that if statement made today in the Court is not adhered to, petitioners shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that in case petitioners are forced to revive the contempt petition, officer present in the Court may be burdened with costs which shall be personally recoverable.
