These petitions have been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s) in complaint case bearing SC No.45 dated 29.7.2005 registered under Sections 148, 325, 324, 323 read with Section 149 IPC which has been recorded as cross overion in FIR No. 93 dated 21.6.2003 registered under Sections 307, 325, 323 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

It has been stated that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the complaint against the husband of the petitioner (namely Balwinder Singh) in C.R.M-M No.11138 of 2019 who is also father of the petitioner in CRM-M-11165-2019 has been quashed by the judgment and order dated 25.10.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed in CRM-M-35246-2017.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioners, counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw these petitions and states that the petitioners would surrender and move applications for regular bail before the court below and a direction be issued to the court to decide their bail applications expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petitions are dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioners surrender before the court on or before 16.03.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided on merits expeditiously but in any case by 18.03.2019.

Since the main cases have been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
