The petitioner has filed present petition for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus and appointment of a Warrant Officer with a roving writ to visit the spot and to get the detenues, if found in illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6, released from their illegal custody.

Vide order dated 11.03.2019, the Registry was directed to appoint a Warrant Officer with the direction to get the detenues, if found to be in illegal confinement, released.

Report dated 13.03.2019 of the Warrant Officer has been placed on record according to which all the detenues mentioned in the petition were not interested to do the work in the Brick Kiln owned by respondent No.4 and had left the premises with the petitioner alongwith their belongings.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has stated that in view of the report of the Warrant Officer, the petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
