Petitioner Nand Kishore has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 23.8.2017 (Annexure P-1) made in continuation of complaint No.AMR-CT-1770281 dated 18.7.2017 made on police helpline No.181 for taking action against respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion was issued to the respondent-State and in response to the petition, status report by way of affidavit of Sudhanshu Shekhar Srivastava, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City has been filed by learned State counsel. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

A perusal of the reply reveals that after getting the matter thoroughly investigated and on the basis of report dated 11.4.2019 submitted by the SHO P.S. Cantonment and forwarding report submitted by the ACP West, Amritsar City, the letter bearing No.153-PC-COP dated 03.2.2018 marked to SHO P.S.
