Prayer in this petition is for quashing the FIR No. 51 dated 23.02.2016, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Tripri, Patiala along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing, no one has appeared for the petitioner.

While issuing notice of motion on 09.10.2017, it was observed that learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his arguments only for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement with respondent No. 2 and the case was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Thereafter, on 14.12.2017, it was noticed that no settlement could be arrived at between the parties and in the meantime, the trial Court has framed the charge on 07.07.2017. The case is now fixed for prosecution evidence.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.
