The above mentioned two petitions have been brought by the petitioners under the provisions of section 482 Cr. P.C., for quashing of FIR No. 26 dated 15.04.2012, registered at Police Station Lodhowal, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, under sections 323, 342, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC along with all the subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 14.05.2018 passed by this Court, the parties had been directed to appear before trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate for getting

their statements recorded in support of the compromise. The trial Court was also requested to send its report regarding veracity of the compromise apart from informing the names and number of the accused involved and whether any of the accused has been declared proclaimed offender in this case.

Pursuant thereto report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana has been received. It has been reported that the parties have voluntarily entered into compromise with each other and the compromise is without any under influence and coercion. It has also been stated that no accused has been declared proclaimed offender. Out of eight accused involved in this case, accused Santosh has already died and proceedings against him were abated on 7.9.2015.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, both the petitions are allowed and FIR No. 26 dated 15.04.2012, registered at Police Station Lodhowal, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, under sections 323, 342, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC along with all the subsequent proceedings arising out of the same qua the petitioners is quashed.
