In compliance of the previous interim order/s, today Ms. Grewal has produced the status report by way of additional affidavit of Gurjeet Singh Brar, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot and the petitioner's medical report submitted by the Civil Surgeon, Faridkot, which are taken on record. As per the medical report, the medical team has diagnosed the petitioner as a person suffering from mild anxiety with past history of substance use (heroin). He has been advised regular counselling and follow up in the jail. Thus, the reason for which parole is sought does not exist as per the medical report. No ground for any indulgence to be shown to the petitioner is made out.

Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed.
