Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.34 dated 16.01.2019, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the present petitioner was only a helper to the doctor and she has not taken any money from the decoy patient. No termination of pregnancy has taken place.

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The petitioner has been in custody since 16.01.2019. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes or nothing is to be recovered from her as she is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
