Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.169 dated 10.12.2018 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Kot Isse Khan, District Moga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
