Petitioners-Sukhdev Singh and Kali Singh @ Jasvir Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.300 dated 20.10.2018, registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda, under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of the IPC and Section 326 of the IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioners are named in the FIR. Petitioner No.1-Sukhdev Singh is father of petitioner No.2-Kali Singh @ Jasvir Singh. Petitioner No.1-Sukhdev Singh is stated to be armed with *kasia* and petitioner No.2-Kali Singh alias Jasvir Singh is stated to be armed with *dang*. The grievous injury is stated to be on the little finger of left foot of the injured.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 13.03.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 13.03.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
