This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.08 dated 16.1.2019 registered under Sections 452, 323, 326, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Qadian, District Batala.

On 12.3.2019, the following order was passed :-

Counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the order dated 1.3.2019 passed in CRM-M-7596-2019 and CRM-M-6808-2019.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply a copy of the paper book to the learned DAG during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 2.5.2019.

In the meantime, let the petitioners surrender before the IO and he will be relased on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the condition envisaged under Sectioin 43.8 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has accepted these factual assertions and stated that they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 12.3.2019 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
