Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross version under Sections 323/324/325/326/308/354-A/148/149 of IPC registered vide DDR No.31 dated 27.10.2017 and DDR No.20 dated 02.11.2017 in FIR No.53 dated 27.10.2017 registered under Sections 326/324/323/148/149 of IPC at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 15.02.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh, states that in the aforesaid case, a SIT was constituted which has completed the investigation and recovery has been effected from the petitioner. He

further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.02.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
