It comes out that petitioner sought parole to meet his family members. The Commissioner, Rohtak Division Rohtak vide order dated 21.2.2019, allowed the parole to the petitioner for 14 days i.e., from 1.6.2019 to 14.6.2019. Petitioner seeks modification of the said dates.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I am of the view that since the Election Code of Conduct is in operation, it is for this reason that Commissioner, Rohtak Division Rohtak has fixed the dates for parole from 1.6.2019 to 14.6.2019 i.e., after the Model Code of Conduct is over.
