This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.65 dated 14.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 379-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

Allegations in the FIR are that when the complainant along with her sister-in-law/Jaswant Kaur, came back at the gate of Gurudwara Sahib after paying the obeisance, the petitioner snatched her purse.

On instructions from Police official, learned State counsel states that the investigation in this case is complete, challan has been presented and the trial has commenced.

The petitioner is in custody since 14.05.2018. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the

petitioner in custody.

Keeping in view the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
