Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.294 dated 04.08.2018 under Sections 452, 323, 294, 506, 148, 149 IPC (the offence punishable under Section 354 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 12.03.2019 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, a communication dated 24.05.2019 has been received from learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class,

Dera Bassi to the effect that respondent No.2-Rahul Prajapati and respondent No.5-Vicky were the complainants, who have appeared before learned Magistrate and in their separate statements, they have stated that they have not entered into any compromise with the accused persons, but the accused persons under the coercion of police officials had got our signatures on the compromise. Since the compromise has been disputed by the complainants, the very petition seeking quashing of FIR in question on the basis of compromise is liable to be dismissed at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, in case a fresh compromise is arrived at between the parties, they would be at liberty to file a fresh petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
