The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.01 dated 03.01.2019, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

It has been submitted that co-accused Pardeep Singh and the prosecutrix solemnized marriage with each other and sought protection from this court vide order dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed in CRM-M-5514-2019.

The FIR was lodged by the father of the prosecutrix on the basis of suspicion alleging that the petitioner was also the helping hand in the marriage of the prosecutrix with co-accused Pardeep Singh.

Co-accused Harjit Singh has already been granted the benefit

of regular bail by this court vide order dated 12.03.2019, passed in CRM-M-10403-2019. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Boota Singh alias Bhatti is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Fazilka, subject to the following terms:-

- (a) *The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.*
- (b) *In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.*
- (c) *He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.*
