Report dated 09.04.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hoshiarpur has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent No.2-Mamta Rani and accused/petitioners, namely, Jaspreet Singh, Avtar Singh, Surinder Kaur and Harjinder Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the complainant, namely, Mamta Rani is fully satisfied with this settlement

(Annexure-CX) and does not object if the present petition is allowed.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have shown their resolve to end the dispute and have made statements that they have compromised the matter as Annexure P-2 and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 02 dated 07.01.2019 registered at Police Station Mehtiana, District Hoshiarpur under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
