This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuing the appropriate and necessary direction to respondent No. 1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family and further a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to 4 not to harassed the petitioner and his family members.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mandeep Singh Sidhu, SSP, District Sangrur, pointed out that the complaint made by the petitioner was inquired into by the Inquiry Officer. During inquiry proceedings notices were sent to the petitioner to join the said inquiry. However, despite that, the petitioner did not join the inquiry proceedings. Ultimately, Inquiry Officer conducted the said inquiry as per the available records. ASI Narayan Singh had never raided the house of the petitioner. Even the mobile phone location of SI Narayan Singh was cross-checked. He was
