Petitioner Satish Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.72 dated 28.05.2018, registered at Police Station Barara, District Ambala, under Sections 420, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the petitioner has cheated the complainant for ₹36 lacs on the ground of getting allotment of Gas Agency.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 06.02.2019. He is not required for any investigation or

interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may

take long time. The offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
