The petitioners have filed present criminal revision seeking enhancement of interim maintenance granted to them by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak vide order dated 28.01.2019, whereby on a petition filed by them under Section 125 Cr.P.C., the family Court has granted interim maintenance @ Rs.8,000/- per month to petitioner No.1 Usha and Rs.2,000/- per month to petitioner No.2 Kavya, minor daughter of petitioner No.1.

It is the case of the petitioners that the respondent is working in Delhi Police as Constable and is drawing salary of Rs.40,000/- per month. He has no other liability as his mother is a government employee, whereas his father is a retired person and is drawing pension. The awarded interim

maintenance to the petitioners is on lower side and it is difficult for them to sustain.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perusing the impugned order dated 28.01.2019 passed by the family Court, this Court finds that the petitioners have been granted interim maintenance @ Rs.10,000/- per month from the date of filing of the application along with litigation expenses of Rs.11,000/-. The final maintenance is yet to be fixed by the family Court. Therefore, no ground for interference is made out by invoking revisionary jurisdiction of this Court.

Accordingly, affirming the impugned order dated 28.01.2019 passed by the family Court, the present criminal revision, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.

However, it is made clear that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the main petition and the family Court shall decide the same without being influenced with these observations in any manner.
