Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.132 dated 07.08.2018 under Sections 457, 380 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 14.03.2019: -

“... Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay of seven days in registration of the FIR and co-accused of the petitioner, namely Rajinder Kaur @ Rani @ Inderjit Kaur, has already been granted concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 18.12.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-43654-2018...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Muktsar Sahib in the Court today and on instructions from the Investigation Officer and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
