This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of direction to respondent No.2 for removing unauthorized occupation/ possession on the path situated in Krishna Nagar, Rewari made by respondent Nos. 3 to 10.

Perused.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 -Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rewari to consider and decide the representation dated 21.3.2018 (Annexure P-2) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to

them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
