Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.155 dated 19.12.2018 registered under Sections 406/498-A of IPC at Police Station Women, Ludhiana.

This Court while issuing notice of motion in the case, vide order dated 13.03.2019 stayed the arrest of the petitioner. Thereafter, vide order dated 19.07.2019, petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 19.07.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vipin Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide orders dated 13.03.2019 and 19.07.2019 are made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
