Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0003 dated 11.01.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to take his wife from the Court premises itself and respondent No.2 should stay with him without creating any problem.

However, learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 on instructions from his client, states that she(respondent No.2) has never raised any dispute with the petitioner and is ready to stay with him.

Accordingly, the order dated March 13, 2019, whereby arrest of

the petitioner was stayed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.

Petitioner is directed to take his wife from the Court premises
itself.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is required in the case
in any manner, a clear 15 days' notice be given to him.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
