Petitioners raise a grievance that they are being prevented in running their lottery business/agencies from respective shops/stalls at Nabha inspite of having necessary permission/authority/license under the provisions of the Lotteries (Regulations) Act, 1998, Lotteries (Regulations) Rules, 2010 and Punjab State Lotteries Rules, 2015.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length, instant petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to agitate their grievance before respondent no.3 i.e. S.S.P., Patiala along with all supporting/relevant documents in support of their stand that they are duly authorized and are license holders from the competent authority to run their lottery business. In the eventuality of any such representation(s) being preferred before respondent no.3 along with the requisite supporting documents, respondent no.3 would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take necessary steps as he may deem fit in accordance with law.
